Panhalekaji Caves

The Panhalekaji Caves are an ancient group of rock-cut caves located on the banks of the Kotjai River, approximately 35 kilometers from Dapoli. These caves date back to the 3rd century and are believed to have been used by Buddhist monks for meditation and learning. The intricate carvings and sculptures inside the caves depict scenes from Hindu mythology, Jainism, and Buddhism, showcasing the coexistence of different religious ideologies during that era.



Suvarnadurg Fort

Situated on an island off the coast of Harnai, Suvarnadurg Fort is a maritime fortification that once played a crucial role in the Maratha naval defense system. Built in the 16th century during the reign of Shivaji Maharaj, this fort symbolizes the maritime prowess of the Maratha Empire. The fort can be accessed via a boat ride, and its massive walls and bastions offer breathtaking views of the Arabian Sea.



Keshavraj Temple

Nestled amidst lush greenery and a serene natural setting, the Keshavraj Temple is an ancient shrine dedicated to Lord Vishnu. This temple is believed to be over 300 years old and is accessible via a scenic trek through coconut groves and streams. Chandika Devi Temple

Harnai and Anjarle – Landmarks of History

Harnai and Anjarle villages near Dapoli are historically significant due to their ancient ports, forts, and temples. The Harnai port was once a bustling trade center during the Maratha and British periods, and the Anjarle Ganesh Temple (Kadyawarcha Ganpati) is an iconic heritage site with a history dating back centuries.



Traditional Fishing Practices

Fishing in Dapoli has been practiced for generations, with many local families relying on it as their primary source of income. Traditional fishing methods, such as using hand-woven nets, small wooden boats (referred to as "dinghies"), and community-based fishing cooperatives, are still widely prevalent. These methods showcase sustainable and eco-friendly fishing practices.

Fishing Boats: Small to medium-sized wooden and mechanized boats are commonly used.

Nets and Techniques: Cast nets, drag nets, and longlines are typical tools, reflecting the expertise of local fishermen.

Sustainable Practices: Many local communities practice rotational fishing and avoid overfishing during breeding seasons.
